On Friday, August 28, 2026, at 11:00 a.m., Chapin American Legion Post 193, the Missing in America Project (MIAP) and supporting veteran organizations will lay to rest the cremated remains of 12 previously unclaimed veterans at Fort Jackson National Cemetery.

The veterans served in the U.S. Army, U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Navy, and U.S. Air Force, with service spanning from World War II through the Vietnam era and beyond.

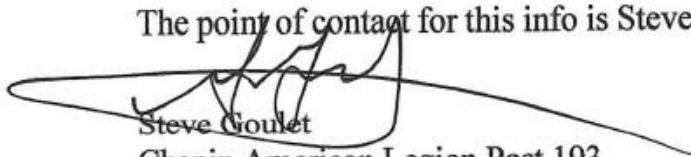
These veterans honorably served their country when called upon to do so and deserve to be laid to rest with the honor and dignity earned through their service to our nation. The American Legion, MIAP and supporting veteran organizations will ensure these Patriots receive the dignified interment they deserve.

The cremated remains will be transported by Dunbar Funeral Home and escorted to Fort Jackson National Cemetery from Chapin American Legion Post 193, 102 Lexington Ave, Chapin, South Carolina. The procession will depart the Post at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, August 28.

The service will begin at 11:00 a.m. at Fort Jackson National Cemetery and will be officiated by Past Chapin American Legion Post 193 Chaplain Jude Peck. Honor Guards provided by the U.S. Army, U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Navy, U.S. Air Force, and Rock Hill American Legion Post 34 will render military honors.

The public is invited and encouraged to attend and help ensure that these veterans are not laid to rest alone.
